USER INSTRUCTIONS

Congratulations on your new MYERS grinder system. With proper care and by following a few simple guidelines your grinder pump will give you years of dependable service.

GENERAL INFORMATION

In order to provide you with suitable wastewater disposal, your home is serviced by a low pressure sewer system. The key element in this system is the Myers grinder pump. The tank collects all raw sewage from the house. The solids materials are then ground into a fine slurry to be pumped to the wastewater treatment line or disposal plant.

PUMP FAILURE ALARM

Your Myers system is provided with an **alarm** that will signal in the event of a high water level in the basin. **This consists of a flashing red light and an audio alarm**. The alarm provides adequate warning to the user that service is required. **Please contact us for service immediately if you notice that the alarm is activated.** The audio alarm can be silenced by flipping a switch on the control panel. The red light will continue to flash until the problem is corrected. Please limit water usage until authorized service personnel arrives and corrects the problem.

CAUTION: DO NOT DISCONNECT POWER TO THE UNIT!

Your grinder pump cannot dispose of wastewater without electrical power. If electric power service is interrupted, keep water usage to a minimum.

CARE AND USE FOR THE MYERS GRINDER PUMP

The Myers grinder pump is capable of accepting and pumping a wide range of materials found in domestic sewage. Regulatory agencies advise that the following items should not be introduced into any sewer either directly or through a kitchen waste disposal unit:

GLASS, METAL, PLASTIC (toys, utensils, etc.), SANITARY NAPKINS OR TAMPONS, SEAFOOD SHELLS, BABY WIPES, DIAPERS, RAGS, CLOTHING, etc.



In addition, you must **NEVER** introduce into any sewer any of the following:

EXPLOSIVES, FLAMMABLE MATERIAL, OIL, GREASE, STRONG CHEMICALS, GASOLINE

PERIODS OF DISUSE

With the Myers grinder pump, there are no problems or special instructions needed if you leave your home unoccupied for a period of time.
